Agenda

Treasurer Jim Katzer called the meeting to order at 1:37 p.m. in Pat Kennedy's absence. Those in attendance were Carl Armijo (Town of Castle Rock), Tom Clayton (CAPA), Vern Tabert (Arapahoe County), Jim Katzer (Arapahoe County), Scott Dunn (Tencate Geosynthetics), Ken Wood (RockSol), Dave Potter (City & County of Denver), Bob Syme (City of Colorado Springs), and Pamela Weimer (MGPEC). Pat Kennedy (City & County of Denver) arrived later.

Next Meeting

Meeting Minutes

The May 26, 2011 minutes were reviewed. Jim Katzer made a motion to approve the minutes as submitted, Pat Kennedy seconded and the minutes were approved unanimously.

Treasurer's Report

Jim Katzer presented the Treasurer's Report. The current balance of the checking account is \$3,637.04. The savings account balance is \$7,427.63 for a total of \$11,064.67. The initial check issued for the Condon Trust account was never cashed so the bank was contacted and a new check issued in January. That check has also not been cashed. Vern Tabert will contact the bank again and a third check will be issued and deposited directly into the trust account (not through the mail). Carl Armijo made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report and issuance of the third check to the Condon trust, Pat Kennedy seconded and the motion was approved unanimously.

Asphalt Thickness Design Equations Issue

Dave Potter will be meeting with the programmer on Monday. He will be reviewing and confirming the numbers output report. The software will run on WindowsXP but will need to find a new programmer for Windows 7 and Vista. Dave asked for an amount up to \$500 to be authorized for production of the CD's. Pat Kennedy made a motion to approve the authorization, Jim Katzer seconded and the motion was approved unanimously. Dave will also put together a proposal for getting a new programmer for the updates.

2011 MGPEC Task Forces

Roadway Rehabilitation – The group met recently and the minutes are posted on the website. The task force members are continuing to work on several issues. The group will be meeting on August 16th.

Life-Cycle Cost Analysis – Tom Clayton (Asphalt) – CDOT is issuing new specifications. The committee will review that document and see if MGPEC wants to adopt the CDOT document or make minor modifications first. They will also be looking at what numbers need to be used for the software.

Subgrade Preparation – Scott Dunn – The group will be meeting again in August. Scott will be sending an email out with the information.

Open Discussion

Warm Mix Asphalt – Tom Clayton. Tom asked about including language in MGPEC's specification to include allowing or not objecting to the use of WMA. Asphalt mixes under 270° are considered WMA; over 270° is HMA. He is also suggesting that the steering committee consider revising specification text to allow for reduced placement temperature requirements when using WMA. Tom will send an example of the language and a sample specification to Pamela Weimer to distribute to the MGPEC Steering Committee for review and the group can discuss at the August meeting.

Reclaimed Asphalt Shingles – Bob Syme. The City of Colorado Springs will be laying this mix in the next few weeks. The group discussed different forms of this mix and how they are performing. Bob will send the date and location to Pamela for distribution to the database.
