**Meeting Minutes**

The September 20, 2012 minutes were reviewed. Dave Potter noted that MGPEC was misspelled in the paragraph related to Charlie Atherton's discussion. Vern Tabert motioned to approve the September minutes as corrected. Dave Potter seconded and the minutes were unanimously approved.

**Treasurer's Report**

Vern Tabert presented the Treasurer's Report. The current balance of the checking account is \$1,802.15. The savings account balance is \$7,438.83 for a total of \$9,240.98. Russ Higgins using Pat Kennedy's proxy made a motion to approve the treasurer's report, Terry Von Clausburg seconded. The report was approved unanimously.

**Asphalt Thickness Design Equations Issue**

Dave Potter has obtained the code. Tom Pieters is trying to get help from programmers to make modifications to the program.

**2012 MGPEC Task Forces**

The geotechnically stabilized subgrade specification is in progress. Work is being done on geotextiles and they will address geogrids after that. There was a discussion of quality control / quality assurance issues.

Discussion of the chemically stabilized subgrade specification was tabled until the next meeting.

John Cheever is working on surface treatments for asphalt such as slurry seal, chip seal, etc.

Jamie Johnson is working on various concrete repairs such as joint sealing, partial and fill depth rehab.

**Specifications Manual**

Pat Kennedy is working on the renumbering scheme for the overall specification manual. There was no update at this time.

Tom Pieters is the taskforce leader for rewriting Item 9. Pamela Weimer sent out an email seeking participation. No update at this time.

### **Open Discussion**

There was a discussion of cold mix asphalt during the warmer months when the use of cut-back asphalt is restricted.

Don Clem stated that Weld County is doing some full depth rehab using cement as a stabilizer and applying a chip seal for the surface.

Bill Moritz, Wright Asphalt, introduced himself and his company. His company made a presentation to the steering committee earlier this year on their specialty; rubberized asphalt for surface treatments.
