Meeting Minutes

The December 13, 2012 meeting minutes were reviewed. Jim Katzer motioned to approve the minutes as submitted. Scott Wenger seconded and the minutes were approved unanimously.

Treasurer's Report

Jim Katzer presented the Treasurer's Report. The current balance of the checking account is \$1,351.95. The savings account has a balance of \$7,440.69 for a total of \$8,792.62. Dave Potter motioned to approve the treasurer's report. Vern Tabert seconded and the report was approved unanimously. After confirmation from Tom Pieters that the new version of the software will be available this spring, the 2013 invoice letters will be going out in the next couple of weeks with that information included in the accomplishments.

Asphalt Thickness Design Equations Issue

Tom Pieters is working on the software with a programmer. He confirmed that Version 4 will be released spring of 2013. He is working to finish up cost analysis and putting in spreadsheet using feedback from members. Pat Kennedy will make an announcement at the annual meeting of release date. Dave Potter and Tom Pieters will then begin work on Version 5 which may include some Perpetual and Mechanistic / Empirical Design Methodology. Tom will also get pricing from the programmer to allow for posting on the website and having members download directly from there. The steering committee will need to determine pricing prior to release.

2013 MGPEC Task Forces

Joe LaHeist reported that the Slurry Seal specification had previously been submitted.

The Task Force will discuss chip seal at its next meeting on February 5. It will be held in Room 105 of the CDOT Maintenance headquarters at I-70 & Holly.

Dave Potter reported that the review of Item 18 is in its final stages. The specification will also include FlashPatch.
