Meeting Minutes

The August 22, 2013 meeting minutes were reviewed. Joe LaHeist motioned to approve the minutes as submitted, Joe LaHeist, using Jim Katzer's proxy, seconded and the minutes were approved unanimously.

Treasurer's Report

Vern Tabert presented the Treasurer's Report. The current balance of the checking account is \$2,558.47. The savings account has a balance of \$7,446.27 for a total of \$10,004.74. Pat Kennedy, using David Rausch's proxy, moved to approve the treasurer's report, Joe LaHeist seconded and the Treasurer's Report was approved unanimously.

MGPEC Software

There was no update available on the software.

2013 MGPEC Task Forces

Chip Seal - Item 15: There was some confusion about the possibility that changes were made after this specification after it was approved by the steering committee during the August meeting. No changes were made. The version approved in August is the final version.

Concrete Joint Sealing/Resealing – Item 13b: The specification should be completed and an electronic copy available prior to the next steering committee meeting.

Life Cycle Cost Analysis: No update was available.

Techniques and Treatments: The next techniques and treatments task force meeting is October 8. There was some discussion about the possibility of reviewing additional treatments. One of the first things this task force did was to survey interest in a wide range of treatments. The task force would only review or create specifications of significant interest to the MGPEC membership. There are two items remaining for the Techniques and treatments task force: Partial depth and full depth concrete repairs.

Fabrics: No update was available.

Item 5 – Chemically Stabilized Subgrade

The revision of this specification was completed in 2012. It was brought up for approval in October 2012 but tabled for further comment. Joe LaHeist brought the item up for discussion during the August 2013 meeting. The steering committee requested additional time to review the specification and comments

were to be completed by September 20, 2013. The approval of this specification will be placed on the December 2013 agenda.

Specifications Manual

The group discussed issues related to the formatting of the manual including the capitalization and bolding of AGENCY and CONTRACTOR throughout the manual. They discussed different options for the manual numbering system for categories. One option would be to use item numbers 1-19 for everything under pavements, 20-29 for asphalt and 30-40 for concrete sections. Pat Kennedy will revise the list and submit to the committee. The group will also need to decide the decimal system and description under each Item number. Once the numbers have changed, Dave Potter recommended showing a table on the website showing the old numbers with the revised numbers for each Item. The committee will discuss the numbering system and formatting and guidelines during the December meeting.
