Jim Katzer made a motion to approve the agenda, Scott Wenger seconded and the agenda was approved.

**Meeting Minutes**

The October 23, 2014 meeting minutes were reviewed. Scott Wenger motioned to approve the minutes as submitted, Jim Katzer seconded and the minutes were approved unanimously.

**Treasurer's Report**

Jim Katzer presented the Treasurer's Report. The current balance of the checking account is \$1875.17. The savings account has a balance of \$5,951.99 for a total of \$7,827.16. Dave Potter moved to approve the treasurer's report, Scott Wenger using Todd Rullo's proxy, seconded and the Treasurer's Report was approved unanimously.

**MGPEC Software**

Tom Pieters reported there was no progress on the software. He has found that the software doesn't work on Windows360. Tom is going to check to see if any of the assistants at the City of Aurora would be willing to help resolve the issues.

**Reformatting of the MGPEC Specifications Manual**

Dave Potter rewrote some sections of Items 5 & 6 for readability and logical sequence. The committee will review those two items by the end of the month. Some of the tables were not numbered consistently; decimals were used on some and dashes on others. The committee decided when there are multiple tables they should be labeled with dashes; i.e. 20.1-1. The table names will be given the number of the section or subsection (smaller of the two) the table is located in.

Tom Clayton had made some minor revisions to Item 20 to bring it current. His changes were sent to the committee previously. Jim Katzer reviewed it for the reformatting. Pamela will resend Items 5, 6, 20.

There are four specifications that go beyond X.9 so we need to either go to 3 digits or a number/letter system. The committee decided to go to X.100, X.110, etc. Subsections will remain the same.

Items 24, 25, and 26 still need to be reviewed. Dave Potter will do Item 24, Scott Wenger will do Item 25 and Tom Pieters will do Item 26.

All Item reviews should be completed by Tuesday, January 6, 2015. We will then post online on February 1, 2015.

#### 2014/2015 MGPEC Task Forces

Techniques and Treatments: Dave Potter and Jamie Johnson co-chair the task force. The committee still needs to work on concrete repairs. No date has been set for the next meeting.

Geogrids task force: Andrei Bedoya will chair the committee. Dave Potter will contact Andrei to set a meeting date.

Full Depth Replacement/Recycle: Tom Pieters will chair the committee. Jeff Weitzel, Don Clem and Charlie Atherton will get information to Tom Pieters to review before setting the meeting date for the task force.

#### **2015 Annual Meeting**

The group tentatively chose Monday, April 13, 2015 at Centerpoint in Aurora. Jim Katzer will check to see if that date is available for the venue.

Suggestions for presentations included APWA accreditation for cities, certifications, breakouts covering specific certifications, maintenance, highlighting MGPEC specification changes, and what's new in design in asphalt and concrete. The committee decided to focus on certifications and meeting federal regulations.
