Meeting Minutes

The May 28, 2015 meeting minutes were reviewed. David Rausch motioned to approve the minutes as submitted, Scott Wenger seconded and the minutes were approved unanimously. The March 26, 2015 meeting minutes were approved by email vote of the Steering Committee.

Treasurer's Report

Tom Pieters recommended reviewing Virginia's specification as well. The committee discussed a project in Wyoming on highway 287 based on soil type. Jeff will schedule a meeting of the task force to discuss the specification.

Transportation Asset Management: Mike Skinner provided minutes from the meeting on June 30th. The task force discussed asset management goals and MAP21 requirements. The goal of the task force is to

provide uniform asset management in the DRGOC area with the focus on pavement management. The next meeting will be August 4th, 10:00am at CAPA's office.

Concrete Specification: The task force has met twice. They have discussed air entrainment and slump. The new ACI specification is based on water to cement ratio. The current specification may be split into three specifications. The group will meet again next week.
