### **Meeting Minutes**

The March 26, 2015 meeting minutes were reviewed but not approved and will be approved at the next meeting.

### **Treasurer's Report**

Jim Katzer presented the Treasurer's Report. The current balance in the checking account is \$1,834.28. The saving account has a balance of \$5,953.47 for a total of \$7,787.75. The report was reviewed and discussed but not approved. It will be approved at the next meeting.

### **MGPEC Software**

Tom Pieters is in the final review. Software will be internet based. The developer has spent 150 hours on developing the software. Pam will look in the past meeting minutes to determine what amount was approved by the Steering Committee to spend on software development in the past. Tom Pieters will propose an amount to be paid to the developer at the next meeting. The developer is requesting that he is allowed to place his name on the software. These two items will be put forth for approval at the next meeting.

### **MGPEC Task Forces**

**Techniques and Treatment** – No progress has been made.

**Geogrids** – Dave will contact Andre Bedoya to start the task force again.

**Full depth replacement/recycle** – Tom Pieters will ask Pam to send out a request for volunteers to start the task force. This task force could have a hard time putting a specification together so a

guideline will be considered. The task force will also determine where the new FDR section will reside in the manual. Jeff Weitzel will co-chair the task force with Tom.

**Concrete Specification Task Force** – Concrete specifications are out of date and a task force will be formed to review and update the existing specification. The concrete industry will provide a chair for this task force. Tom will have Pam send out a request for volunteers to start this task force.

**Transportation Asset Management Task Force** – The goal would be to standardize pavement management in the DRCOG area and implement an asset management plan that is consistent. The task force will work to understand what DRCOG is doing to implement MAP 21 and conduct a survey of the membership to determine how MAP 21 plans are being made. Long term goal is to get all DRCOG membership on the same pavement evaluation system which has big benefits. Deliverables is a report back to the group about MAP 21 implementation and survey results about asset management in the region. Jim Katzer made a motion to move forward with this task force and Dave Potter seconded with Pat Kennedy's proxy. Motion passed unanimously.

**Asphalt Specification Revisions** – Tom Pieters is halfway through the proposed asphalt specification and will provide a final version for review soon. MGPEC will work on promoting MGPEC specifications at the Public Works Director level.

#### **Reformatting of the MGPEC Specifications Manual**

The reformatting is on hold until the asphalt specification review is completed and will be discussed at the next meeting.

#### **Steering Committee Elections**

Everyone on the ballot was elected. Officers were re-elected and are as follows: Tom Pieters – Chair, Scott Wenger – Co-Chair, and Jim Katzer – Treasurer.

#### **Open Discussions**

Melody Perkins mentioned that R-value studies are in the works. She also mentioned that the CDOT User cost software will be available for users on the web soon. The Pavement Design Manual and the Field Material Manual will be done soon. CDOT is testing different paints for steel over the next few years which will lead to modifications to the Steel Painting Specification.

CAPA, PCA, and CRMCA will sponsor the lunch portion of the annual meeting and split the \$766.72 three ways. Pam will send out invoices in June.
