Agenda

Scott Wenger motioned to approve the agenda, Todd Rullo seconded and the agenda was accepted.

Meeting Minutes

The October 27, 2016 meeting minutes were reviewed. Jim Katzer motioned to approve the minutes as submitted. Scott Wenger seconded and the minutes were approved unanimously.

Treasurer's Report

Jim Katzer presented the Treasurer's Report in Kurt Muehlemeyer's absence. The current balance of the checking account is \$2,526.39. The savings account has a balance of \$5,958.84 for a total of \$8,485.23. Dave Potter, using Pat Kennedy's proxy, motioned to approve the treasurer's report, Steve Eubanks seconded and the Treasurer's Report was approved unanimously.

MGPEC Pavement Design Standards Group

The steering committee changed the name from MGPEC Action Group to Pavement Design Standards Group. The values are in but need to be compiled and then a draft will be sent to the action group for review. They met in November and will meet December 15. 2016 MGPEC Task Forces

Full Depth Replacement/Recycle: Jeff Weitzel chairs the task force. The specification was sent to the steering committee for review. Scott Wenger only had minor comments concerning formatting. Jim Katzer asked about cement, fly ash, or lime for subgrade stabilization. The group discussed if it should be included in this specification or just refer to the specification where it is discussed. The group decided to keep it separate. Melody offered to run the final specification by CDOT employees that had reviewed their specification to see if they spotted any items that may be misinterpreted. The group discussed the Item numbers and where to place the specification. It was decided to leave Items 7 and 8 open, Items 9-11 will be reserved for FDR related topics, Item 12 becomes Separation Fabric and Item 13

will be Aggregate Base Course. Jeff will renumber the specification and make the discussed revisions and resend to Pamela to forward to the steering committee.

Transportation Asset Management: Mike Skinner and Steve Mueller chair the task force. No update was available.

Concrete Specification: Dave Potter is chairing the committee. Dave met with Eric Prieve at CDOT a couple of months ago. They are working on the material part of the specification. JT Mesite will meet with Dave to discuss.

Bylaw Revisions for MGPEC

Bylaw Revisions: Jim Katzer met with Steve Mueller who offered some suggestions to the bylaws. Jim Katzer reviewed and drafted the revisions. The main change is to allow industry/consultants a position on the steering committee. There were also revisions concerning membership, meetings and schedule, industry representation, and quorum number. Jim handed out copies and reviewed the changes he was suggesting. The group discussed the revisions. Jim will incorporate the discussed changes and resend to the committee.

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2017 Annual Meeting

Jim will check to see if CentrePoint is available on Monday, April 10, 2017. The group was asked to bring ideas for topics and speakers to the January meeting.

Open Discussion

Charlie Atherton reported about a project that they recently did for the City of Colorado Springs that has looked at a number of fixes for cracking. He showed photos and a sample of what they used for the repairs. He will keep the group updated on the performance.

Melody Perkins said CDOT completed a study to determine actual truck loading on state highways and determine the resulting damage associated with the overweight truck. They worked with the Colorado State Patrol on four highways and did random stops. They had 13 months of data and the report has been completed.

Melody also reported that Table 6.6 of the CDOT pavement design manual is being revised.
